MATCHED SAVINGS PROGRAMS

Participants in United Way's Matched Savings Programs can build their assets through matched savings for Homeownership, Small Business Ownership, or Post- Secondary Education.

HOMEOWNERSHIP

The Matched Savings Homeownership Program helps individuals and families purchase their first home through a 2:1 savings match. You save \$2,000, and we match \$4,000.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Philadelphia, Montgomery, Delaware, Chester County (PA), Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, or Cumberland County (NJ).
- The adjusted gross income of the household is equal to or less than 400% of the poverty line.

SMALL BUSINESS OWNERSHIP

The Matched Savings Small Business Program helps grow our region's economy by offering entrepreneurs a 2:1 match. You save \$1,500, and we match \$3,000. In collaboration with our partners, this program allows small businesses to purchase equipment and other necessities to help their business grow.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Philadelphia, Montgomery, Delaware, Chester County (PA), Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, or Cumberland County (NJ).
- The adjusted gross income of the household is equal to or less than 400% of the poverty line.
- Participant must be majority owner of the business.

POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

The Matched Savings Post-Secondary Education Program provides a powerful incentive for individuals by matching their savings for education 3:1. Match Savings is designed to support savings for higher education, with select differences:

Match Savings Post-Secondary Education Participants

- Can attend any type of post-secondary institution (a 4-year college or university, a 2-year college, or a trade school).
- Are primarily adult learners, but may also be recent high school graduates.
- Save \$1,000 and receive 3:1 match of \$3,000.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Philadelphia, Montgomery, Delaware, Chester County (PA), Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, or Cumberland County (NJ).
- The adjusted gross income of the household is equal to or less than 400% of the poverty line.
- Proof of enrollment to a post-secondary institution (a 2- or 4-year college, or trade school).

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
